The Reserve Bank has stated that efforts, including a conciliatory meeting under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 on September 5, are being made to resolve the issues. As such, strike by Class III employees, if resorted to, will be illegal. In any case, all its offices will remain open on September 6, 2001 and it will try to provide the required services to its constituents and public.
